Information and Instructions for Volunteers

The Roosters Foundation of Orange County welcomes and thanks you for your interest in helping us fill 3,000 boxes of food with a turkey, fresh produce, canned goods, nutrition bars and toys to feed a family of 8-10 people a Holiday dinner. They will be distributed to 55 non-profit groups who give them to needy families they support.

Date/Time:

Saturday, December 17th 8:30am – noon set up assembly line and repackage fresh produce and toys
Sunday, December 18th 8:30am – 1:00pm - assemble and fill 3,000 boxes of food and clean up area.

Location:

Second Harvest Food Bank of Orange County - 8014 Marine Way, Irvine, CA
Sand Canyon exit from 405 or 5. Marine Way is immediately north of the 5. Turn right toward the great balloon. Turn right at the next stop sign and follow the signs about 1 mile.

Registration

Everyone who comes into the warehouse must come in the north door through the registration area and receive a bracelet confirming you have registered. You will be asked to complete and sign a liability waiver for each person. This is required by Second Harvest.

The form is attached. Please print, complete and sign for each person and bring to registration.

Clothes

No open toe shoes! You will not be allowed into the warehouse.

Recommend bring a light jacket (the warehouse will be cool in the morning), gloves and a box cutter or pocket knife

Children – 8 years and older

While we encourage youngsters to participate and learn the value of helping others, parents must continually monitor all children. There will be several forklifts delivering food to the line and taking filled boxes to the loading docks. Children under 8 are not recommended.

Recycle

We will have water for volunteers. Please empty the bottle and put in one of the marked containers. They are used to raise funds for one of our charities.

Lunch

We will be serving lunch after the boxes are filled. It will be on the south side of the building. Please help keep the area picked up of all trash.

Clean up after lunch

Please help throughout the day by breaking down and moving empty boxes from the assembly area.

Please stay until all trash is picked up. We always leave the warehouse cleaner than we found it. If everyone stays and helps, it happens in about 15 minutes.
