Roosters Feeding Program Update

Feeding OC update:

- 11/26 JOYA Scholars provided 16 volunteers, Jon Giberson & Carol Rundback lead the group with great success creating 1,000 meals.

- 11/27 had 25 volunteers and created over 1,000 meals

- 12/4 had 22 volunteers, thanks to Randy Fine for being our Roosters liaison.

- 12/12 Alteryx organized their own company event with 18 volunteers and will be giving us a \$2,500 donation towards next year's events. Thank you Pete Robie for being the Rooster liaison.

- 12/27 we had 17 volunteers, with Steve Smith and family attending.

- 12/31 29 volunteers attended, Paul Robidoux liaison and Stephanie Bauer.

A total of 12,000+ meals were created, with 6,744 distributed to charities and 5,256 still to be distributed.

Jim & Jan Gollner continue to do a great job contacting all 60 charities that received food boxes in previous years. Additional charities receiving meals in December were: Food & Toy Giveaway for Orange County Youth and with Congressman Lou Correa, Blind Children's Learning Center, TKO Youth Foundation/Boxing Club, OC Rescue Mission, Veterans Outreach OC and Summer Harvest. We will begin organizing and scheduling more "1,000 Meals for Needy Families" events in 2020.
