Membership - We are looking for a few good men to join the Roosters. A main focus for us this year is to grow our membership to somewhere around 95 to 100 members by the end of the year and we are still around the 85 member mark, so in order to help our cause, we are asking all members to dig deep into their rolodex and invite someone they think would be a good fit to one of our socials, events, or luncheons. For those returning members who have not paid their 2020 dues, please go onto the Rooster website and show us the love!

Feeding Program – We are flourishing in our partnership with Brackens Kitchen, creating ready to eat meals by the thousands. However, we are having a problem finding homes for the prepared meals. We are asking charity liaisons to work with Dan Stone and help connect these meals with hungry families.

Food & Wine – We are off to a great start!!! We have 393 wine tickets sold, which is 90 more than this time last year, which represents over \$25k. 49 wineries, 13 spirits, and 11 food purveyors. We have now closed vendor registration, as we are at full capacity. We are thrilled to have some big names pouring this year! Silver Oak, Quintessa, Trefethen, Twomey, Pono, Crown Point, Mudita, Ascension, Ondule', J. Lohr, Tears of Llorona Tequila, and many more! Thank you to our Wine Committee and leadership from John Trapani for their hard work to make this happen.

The entertainment for the evening will be provided by none other than the Tijuana Dogs!!! As for the Chefs Experience, all 15 chefs have committed to the event. We currently have 11 tables filled so far, representing over \$52k in sponsorship income, well ahead of last year at this same point. Even though we may be slightly ahead of schedule, we still need to fill 4 more tables. So, go out there and spread the word!!!! Remember Coffee is for closers!



Rooster Lunch Speaker - Cathy Rigby "The McCoy Rigby Arts Mission"

Cathy Rigby is an actress, speaker, and former artistic gymnast. Born December 12, 1952 she has been married to Tom McCoy since September 11, 1982.

Cathy was the first real American female gymnastics star on television. Her biggest moment came in 1970 when she was the first American to win a World Championship medal, taking silver on the balance beam. Her performance in the 1968 Summer Olympics helped to popularize the sport of gymnastics in the United States.

During her gymnastics career, Cathy won numerous international medals - including eight gold - and in 1998, she was inducted into the International Gymnastics Hall of Fame. When Cathy retired from the sport, she joined ABC Sports for 18 years, providing expert commentary on the sport of gymnastics around the world. During this time, ABC's venerable Wide World of Sports named her one of "America's Most Influential Women in Sports."

After seven years of intense voice and theatrical training, she embarked on a new career in performing arts, touring in national and regional productions, and honored with the National Broadway Theatre Award, "Ovation" Lifetime Achievement Award and the 2004 Distinguished Lifetime Service Award from The League of American Theatres and Producers.

Cathy is the Executive Director of the McCoy Rigby Arts Mission, a non-profit organization providing top education and professional arts training as well as creating necessary and successful outreach programs for the underserved Orange County youth.

Andy Johnson was a Roosters member for many years, and recently passed away. A memorial service was held in his honor in Newport Beach on February 20, 2020. At least a dozen Roosters members were in attendance to say goodbye to an old friend.
