

Lucky for the Roosters we have a plethora of great minds to help come up with great ideas to at least bring in some funds to help those less fortunate...and lucky for the Roosters one of those minds is our own Director of Events, Penny Strenger.

Penny, had brought to my attention the use of a virtual event that could help us bring in some much needed monies for our charity partners. All we had to do was find a location to stream our fundraiser, some A/V people and invite our friend, Jim Nye to be our auctioneer.

We were lucky to have a few volunteers like Rooster President David Selleck and supporter Shelley Watanabe on hand to help setup and participate...as well as Dr. and Mrs. Fine for allowing us to use their home to stream the event from. However, the real success can only be measured by the commitment of someone driving it from beginning to end and that was Penny. Penny's commitment to the Roosters Foundation and its success is second to none and it showed when we needed the funds the most to help our charity partners.

We had initially set our goal at \$40,000, but by the end of the evening we had raised \$100,000 and after a week since the fundraiser we had raised an additional \$15,000 bringing our total to **\$115,000!**

Each One, Reach One

I plan to work with incoming Membership Chair John Trapani on an "Each One, Reach One" effort to increase membership thru our existing roster. We all have different social and professional circles that we can use to recruit new Roosters to the mission. It seems logical to task existing members to reach out to their friends and colleagues and identify potential candidates. The PR Committee would then incorporate this program into our messaging and membership meetings and events. I envision tracking and publishing results to encourage participation.

Specific examples of how our fundraising and grant making efforts reach local children and the impact we support will be developed and shared across our media platforms.






