Feeding OC in 2021:

Great news - we're up and running with two volunteer opportunities!

Great news. Feeding OC had two events packaging and distributing food for 50 families of Magnolia Service Academy in Santa Ana. On Friday, 4/30 at 10 AM at Bracken's Kitchen, volunteers: Stephanie Bauer, Jon Giberson, Cat Richards & me package 50 bags with dry or canned food, masks and small bottles of hand sanitizers. Cat Richards of Bracken's Kitchen received the donated food boxes of items from local sources, totaling approx. 20 pounds each.

In addition, the Congressman team, including Janet Brown, coordinated with Think Together to provide free books to the kids. Think Together "delivers nationally-recognized after school programs, early learning, enrichment, and school improvement in over 400 schools in California from San Diego to San Francisco – serving over 200,000 students."

On Saturday, 5/1 at Magnolia Service Academy, in coordination with Congressman Lou Correa, assistants, school volunteers, Rooster volunteers: Jon Giberson & Doug Richards transported the 100 pans, totaling 800 meals in their SUV's from Bracken's Kitchen to the school. Additional Rooster Foundation volunteers, Steve Smith & Cat Richards arrived at 8 AM to setup to help distribute at 9:30 AM the meals, bags and boxes to the families.



The event concluded at 11 AM, with everyone having a good time and sense of great satisfaction of a job well done. The Roosters paid \$1,000 for the frozen meals. I'm so happy the Roosters Foundation, could be part of an event helping 50 families in many ways. Thank you to all volunteers and coordinators for supporting the Feeding OC Program.
