

Charity Partner Focus

<u>Advance! On to College</u> provides equity of access to college for historically under-served and under-represented families to enable them to participate in the dream and the promise of a college education. During 2021 and so far in 2022 *Advance! On to College* has accomplished the following tasks.

COVID has allowed Advance! to operate on **two tracks**: counseling and advising students and parents in the office as well as on-line.

- Advance helped **398** students one-on-one in the Advance office with their college admissions applications and another **480** on-line. Advance hired two additional staff to handle the on-line appointments. All students served by Advance! were accepted to college.
- Advance is not without vision and created and conducted **121** out-of-office workshops in schools and other facilities throughout north Orange County, attended by a total of **1,998** parents and students. These are held in both the English and Spanish languages.
- Advance initiated and created on-line videos about college preparation that can be watched via computer over the internet facilitating more flexibility and accessibility to their resources.
- Advance awarded **51** college scholarships to graduating seniors from high schools in La Habra, Buena Park, Fullerton, Anaheim, and Santa Ana. (All scholarship monies are donated, i.e., none come out of Advance's operational budget). Some scholarships are awarded to students already in college to help them stay in college.
- Advance keeps on growing and continues to provide educational and financial support to students who are interested in college and have limited resources including college counseling.

Charity Committee

Earlier this year, there were only three Advocates for the charities for whom we have provided grants. Today all 31 charities have Advocates, and, in some cases, there is more than one Advocate. Thank you to Roosters members who have accepted the role of Charity Advocate!

The Advocates have submitted 31 charity grant requests, which are currently being assessed by the Charity Sub-Committee. This committee was formed by five volunteers plus me to accept the task of reviewing all of the grant applications and preparing a report for the Roosters Grant Review Committee. The latter is comprised of the President, V.P., Immediate Past President, Chair Person from each major Roosters event, and three non-board Roosters members. My responsibility is to chair the committee in a non-voting capacity and only vote in case of a tie. The Grant Review committee makes the final recommendations about how much grant money to award each charity applicant, and submits it to the Roosters Board of Directors for final approval.

As Charity Committee Chair Person this year, I have sought to stay focused on the Roosters mission statement outlined in the Procedures Guide as we review the charities grant requests. Namely, our focus is to provide grants to at-risk and abused children under the age of 18. There has always been debate on the Charity Committee and Grant Review Committee as to how literally we want to consider that statement. During a recent sub-committee meeting, we concluded it is important to broaden the definition a bit to include families of at-risk and abused children as long as there is a direct correlation to the adult family members supporting the children under 18. Afterall, if the family is hurting, it can be tougher to support the kids.

The sub-committee is in the final stages of its review process. I am looking for two non-board Roosters members that would be interested in participating in the Grant Review Committee. MG Affects men, women, and children at any age. Symptoms can be mild or severe, and may vary considerably from one person to another. The disease can affect the ability to speak, use arms and legs, swallow and at its worst, even to breathe. Today, there are treatments, but presently no known cure.
