

Transforming Lives Through Partnership: RMTS Update June 30, 2025

Thanks to the generous \$11,000 grant from the Roosters Foundation of Orange County, StandUp for Kids Orange County successfully expanded our Road Map to Success mentoring program in the Huntington Beach Union High School District. This funding directly enabled us to serve 10 additional homeless students as originally proposed, contributing to our remarkable achievement of enrolling 237 youth ages 12-18 in the RMTS program across all our partner school districts.

The impact of this partnership has been extraordinary. Our 2024 annual report demonstrates that we maintained our 100% graduation rate for all StandUp youth in the Class of 2024, including those supported through the Roosters Foundation grant. These students received comprehensive

wrap-around services including basic needs support, stable housing assistance, mentoring, tutoring, and life skills development. The mentoring relationships developed through RMTS proved crucial, with trained case managers meeting with students twice weekly to provide the direction, support, and accountability that helps vulnerable youth develop confidence and independence.

This grant was instrumental in our broader organizational growth, as we served 1,784 total youth in 2024—an 8% increase from the previous year. The Huntington Beach students supported by the Roosters Foundation were part of our comprehensive approach that delivered over 11,800 points of service across Orange County.

With 8% of our crisis hotline calls coming from Huntington Beach youth, this partnership addressed a critical need in the community. The success of these 10 students represents not just individual achievements, but a model for breaking the cycle of youth homelessness through education stability and mentoring support. We are helping to make a difference!

Dr. Richard Shuldiner is a pioneer in low vision care and a passionate mentor to optometrists around the world. He founded The Shuldiner Low Vision Training Institute and serves as President of the International Academy of Low Vision Specialists. He has trained more than 100 optometrists to provide life-changing care across the United States, Canada, Mexico, South Africa, Israel and Indonesia.

After earning his Doctor of Optometry degree in 1970 from the Pennsylvania College of Optometry, Dr. Shuldiner led a successful private practice in New York and served as Clinical Director of the New York Lighthouse Upstate Clinics. Since 1994, he has maintained a low-vision-only practice in California.

A Diplomate in Low Vision from the American Academy of Optometry, Dr. Shuldiner is recognized internationally for his clinical excellence, leadership, and commitment to restoring independence for those with vision impairment. He's led workshops across six continents, served as Chief Clinical Editor of Managing Low Vision, and was President of the Rialto Lions Club, on the board of San Bernardino Lighthouse, and the American Diabetes Association.

Dr. Shuldiner has lectured to eye care professionals in Russia, Ukraine, Belarius, China, Israel, Canada and throughout the USA. He has appeared on numerous television and radio programs.

Dr. Shuldiner's work stands as a model of service in action—empowering patients, inspiring professionals, and proving that vision loss does not mean life loss.






