- Build sustainable infrastructure that supports growth and execution

Fellow Roosters,

As vice president of Roosters, I'm pleased to share exciting updates that will help us serve our community even better. We're taking steps to modernize our operations while keeping our focus on what matters most – supporting children's charities in Orange County.

To enhance our communication and collaboration, we're establishing a new Tech Chair position. This off-board position will help us make thoughtful decisions about technology that benefits our entire organization.

Our first project includes implementing Google Workspaces, which will make it easier for board members and volunteers to work together. We're also setting up roosters.org email addresses for those who need them, creating a more polished appearance for our communications. Additionally, we're applying for Google Ad Grants for Non-Profits, which would provide \$10,000 monthly (yes, \$120K a year) in free advertising on Google.com searches. This would help us promote our events and reach more volunteers who want to join our cause.

These improvements will help us work more efficiently while maintaining our strong community connections. We're committed to serving our children's charities with greater effectiveness.
